


Painting an underwater scene is not as hard as you think. Follow the steps below to create a fantastic scene.




Start off with blending colors to create the sun/sky blending down with water and sand. You can use any colors for the sky but these yellow, white and pink/orange work good for a sunset sky.



Next dilute some blue-green paint with water to create an overglaze. Make some "u" shapes and make the value darker as you move down the painting.



Add some bright white and mix it with yellow and other shades of orange and red to give it a bright sun effect.



Dilute white with 50% water and add streaks of white for a sun ray effect.



Finish by adding background and foreground images. If you want to add water bubbles you can make cloud like shapes using white and different values of blue.
