Rubric/Instructions for Visual Metaphor Drawing Project. State Standard: Communication and Expression Through Original Works of Art 2.5 Use innovative visual metaphors in creating works of art.

Your Goal:

- 1. You are going to create a visual metaphor **drawing** that relates to your theme.
- 2. Make sure your art is original.
- Make 2 virtual rough draft sketches before you start the project. You will use these sketches to help you with your drawing.
- Your drawing will be on large 12x18 paper.
- 5. Try not to make your visual metaphor overly obvious.
- 5. Use good craftsmanship and be creative.
- Pick a creative title that goes with your theme.
- You must use at least two or three images and blend them together to make your visual metaphor. You can use more images if you like.

Met·a·phor **noun** \'me-tə-,for **also** -fər\: a word or phrase for one thing that is used to refer to another thing in order to

show or suggest that they are similar: an object, activity, or idea that is used as a symbol of something else. What is a visual metaphor? "A visual metaphor is an image used in the place of or in conjunction with another image to suggest an analogy between the images or make a statement with them." "The concept of metaphor can be used with visual terms. For example, a visual metaphor composed of a clock enclosed within the dollar sign can express visually the verbal metaphor time is money."

Rubric: Project Worth 40 Points and Two virtual sketches worth 10 points.

Virtual sketches. To get all 10 points on the virtual sketches:

0_10 Points. The virtual sketches can be done with "masking" on mac "pages" or another paint program like photoshop. Upload your two virtual sketches to google classroom. Make sure you have at least two rough draft virtual sketches.

Project. To get all 40 points on the project:

- 0_10 points. The art is complete and is made with care and consideration. You have used large 12 x 18 drawing paper.
- 0_10 points Originality. Your art has a innovative visual metaphor. The artist has not copied exclusively and has come up with a creative and innovative visual metaphor (the blending of multiple images or ideas) that has never been done before (not copied).
- 0__10 points Details: Has included many details that relate to the visual metaphor and have added shading and/or color to the art to make it look finished.
- 0_10 points: Title- Has a creative title that fits with the art and relates to your theme.
